

Gig Harbor Yacht Club Junior Sailing Program Registration form 2011

Our sailing classes are Monday to Friday, open to youths 8 to 18 years old who have demonstrated basic swimming ability. Beginning instruction focuses on sailing fundamentals, basic dinghy handling, safety, and fun. Advanced instruction expands on boat handling techniques, builds on skills learned in previous classes and offers an introduction to racing. Students are assigned to an initial instructor and may be moved to a different instructor depending on their sailing ability.

Instructors are certified by US Sailing Association and trained in water safety and first aid. Classes are 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Life jackets are required and must be worn by all sailors when on docks, in the boats, and on the water.

I authorize GHYC Junior Sailing program staff to provide emergency first aid to my child and transport them to a medical facility or hospital if needed. I authorize release of personal information to any hospital, medical facility, ambulance or medical personnel rendering care. I accept full responsibility for the costs of treatment for my child. Although GHYC Junior Sailing program will take every reasonable precaution to avoid the risk of injury, sailing can be a hazardous activity. I am informed that sailors face risk of injury due to the nature of the environment they are exposed to, they may be injured from contact with their boat or other boats, equipment failure, boat capsizing, immersion in the water, and/or other causes. I acknowledge that sailing is not without risk. I understand that the description of the risks is not complete and unknown or unanticipated risks could result in injury or illness. I assume all risks related to my child/ward's participation in the sailing program. In consideration for my child/ward's use of GHYC Junior Sailing Program boats, equipment, and facilities,

I HEREBY RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the Gig Harbor Yacht Club, GHYC Junior Sailing Program, their members, officers, agents and employees, of and from any and all claims, demands, actions or rights of action, whether personal to me or to a third party, which are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected with the sailing instruction.
